

ORDINANCE NO. 225

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF UNDERWOOD, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SEWER SERVICE CHARGE.

BE it enacted by the City of Underwood, Iowa:

SUBSECTION AMENDED: Chapter 99, Section 02, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Underwood, Iowa, is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

99.02 RATE. Each customer shall pay to the City sewer fees as hereinafter provided.

1. Residential property owners shall pay a monthly charge based upon the amount of water consumed, including a 1,000 gallon minimum charge per property owner, as follows:

2. Multi-dwelling, commercial and industrial property owners shall pay a monthly charge based upon the amount of water consumed as follows:


| Number of Gallons | Current | Effective July 1, 2017 | Effective July 1, 2018 | Effective July 1, 2019 |
|-------------------------------|--------------------------|---------------------------|---------------------------|---------------------------|
| First 2,000 gallons (minimum) | \$12.00 | \$14.40 | \$21.60 | \$24.14 |
| Next 3,000 gallons | \$6.25 per 1,000 gallons | \$ 7.50 per 1,000 gallons | \$ 8.63 per 1,000 gallons | \$ 9.66 per 1,000 gallons |
| Next 5,000 gallons | \$6.00 per 1,000 gallons | \$ 7.20 per 1,000 gallons | \$ 8.28 per 1,000 gallons | \$ 9.27 per 1,000 gallons |
| Next 10,000 gallons | \$5.80 per 1,000 gallons | \$ 6.96 per 1,000 gallons | \$ 8.00 per 1,000 gallons | \$ 8.96 per 1,000 gallons |
| 20,001 gallons and over | \$5.50 per 1,000 gallons | \$ 6.60 per 1,000 gallons | \$ 7.59 per 1,000 gallons | \$ 8.50 per 1,000 gallons |

3. Customers who contribute wastewater, the strength of which is greater than normal domestic sewage (defined as 300 parts per million of five-day biochemical oxygen demand), shall be subject to a surcharge which may be established by ordinance from time to time.
4. Bills or invoices for sewer service shall be issued as promptly as possible following the reading of the customer's meter. All bills or invoices shall be paid in full within twenty (20) days of the date of issuance or shall be considered delinquent.
